- _____ 3. Include the non-refundable \$50 application fee when submitting your on-line application. The application fee can be paid by credit card, debit card or electronic check. Current WSU Alumni Association members should upload a copy of their membership card to be considered for the application fee waiver benefit. All submitted materials become property of Wayne State University.

- _____ 4. Request official transcripts from all prior colleges and universities to be sent directly from the institution to the WSU Office of Graduate Admissions at the address below. Sealed transcripts marked "Issued to Student" and/or any transcript transported or transmitted by the applicant are not considered "official".

- _____ 5. Non-US citizens: Provide a copy of your Permanent Resident Card (both sides), visa, passport, and/or applicable paperwork pertaining to any pending immigration status change request.

- _____ 6. Applicants who have not received a Bachelor's degree or higher in a country where English is the official language are required to submit an official qualifying score from either the TOEFL (79 internet-based, 213 computer-based and 550 paper-based), MELAB (85), or IELTS (6.5) to establish English proficiency. The score must be officially reported by ETS TOEFL, cannot be institutional, cannot be from provided by another university, and must be no more than two years old. Applicants who have received a Bachelor's degree or higher from one of the following countries are exempt from the TOEFL, MELAB or IELTS requirement: Australia, Belize, the British Caribbean and British West Indies, Canada (except Quebec), England, Greenland, Guyana, Ireland, Liberia, New Zealand, Scotland, South Africa, the United States, and Wales.
